

Dear Railway Owners,

Please review Trash & Recycling Reminders at Railway:

All residents should properly dispose of their trash and break down cardboard boxes for recycling. Please note that Styrofoam and plastic wrap are not allowed in the recycling bins and should be placed in the regular trash.

Please remember to schedule bulk pickups with Waste Management **before** moving large items to the trash area. Waste Management can be reached at 305-296-8297.

For bulk item pickup, items need to be separated into two piles: wooden items and metal items. They are collected by different trucks, and if not separated, they will not be picked up. Additionally, a 20-foot clearance is required for the "claw" to properly grab items, as the Waste Management driver does not physically exit the truck.

****Waste Management Pickup Schedule for Railway:****

* ****Recycling:** Monday & Thursday**

* ****Trash:** Tuesday & Thursday**

* ****Large Items:** Railway Homeowners must call Waste Management directly at 305-296-8297 for free pickup.**

****Materials That Can Be Recycled:****

- * Boxboard (e.g., food and cereal boxes)
- * Cardboard (please break down all boxes)
- * Clean aluminum foil
- * Magazines
- * Newspapers and junk mail (including envelopes with plastic windows)
- * Plastic bottles and containers (no film, bags, or Styrofoam)
- * Regular paper
- * Drink and food cartons
- * Rinsed aluminum and metal cans
- * Rinsed glass bottles and jars (remove lids and include them in recycling; no mirrors or window glass)

****Materials That Cannot Be Recycled:****

- * Cigarettes
- * Electronics
- * Food
- * Household chemicals
- * Plant material
- * Plastic bags
- * Water hoses

****Tips for Recycling****

- * Recyclables should not be placed in plastic bags; items in plastic bags will not be picked up.
- * Recycling bins contaminated with garbage will also not be picked up.
- * Please empty and break down all boxes before placing them in the recycling bin.
- * Packing materials (e.g., plastic bags, plastic wrap, Styrofoam, packing peanuts) are rarely recyclable and should be put in the trash.
- * Cardboard wrapped in plastic should be placed in the trash (or remove the plastic and discard it separately).
- * Gift bags or wrap with strings, made of plastic, or with bows are not recyclable.
- * Pizza boxes should generally be put in the trash, unless they are completely free of food and oils.

Please help us keep the trash and recycling area clear and free of litter.
